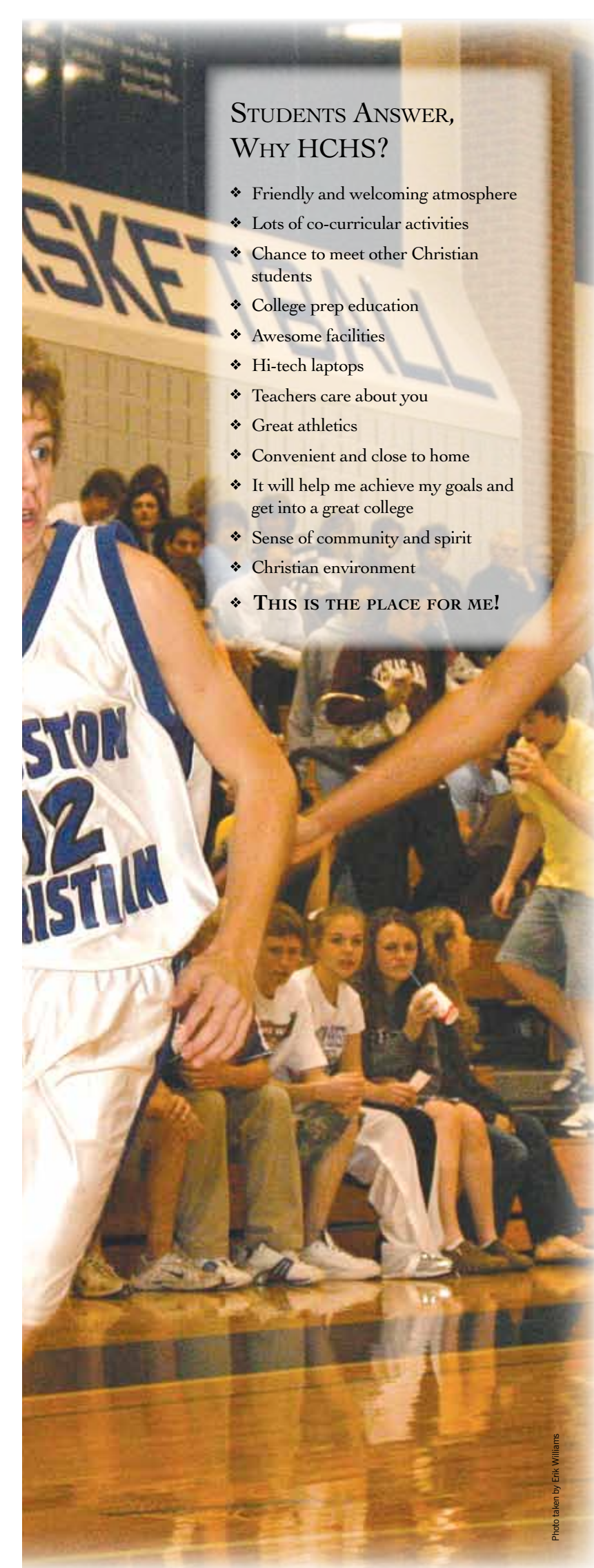

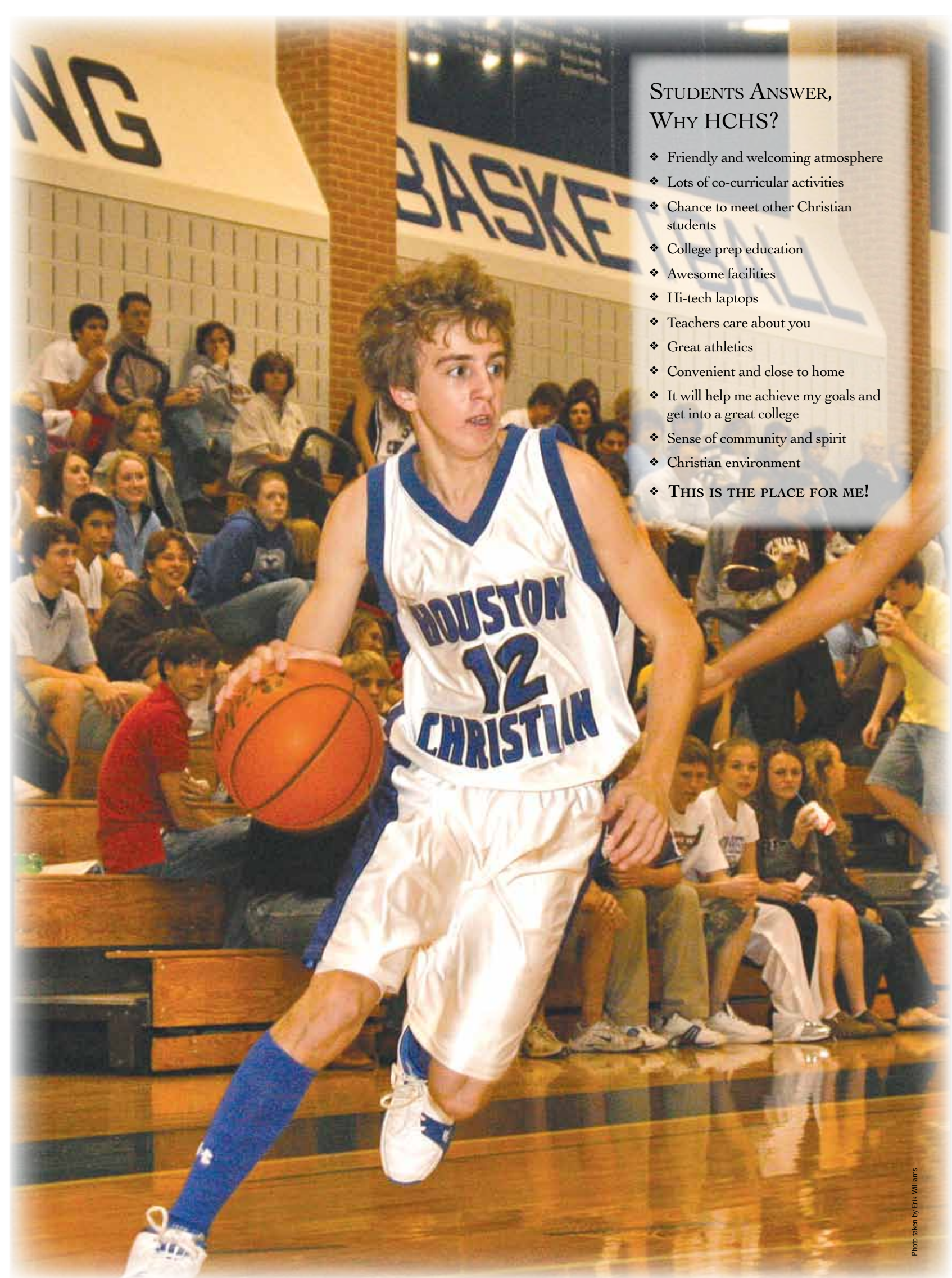

PASSPORT TO LEAD

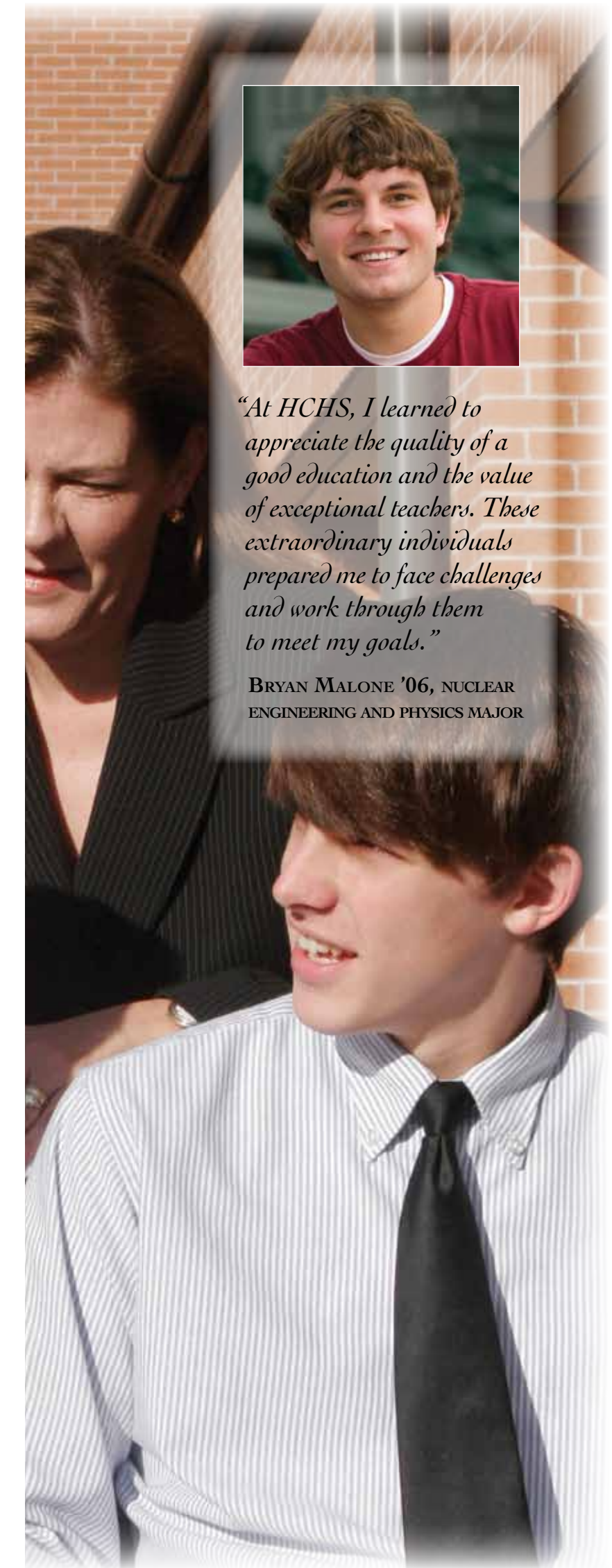

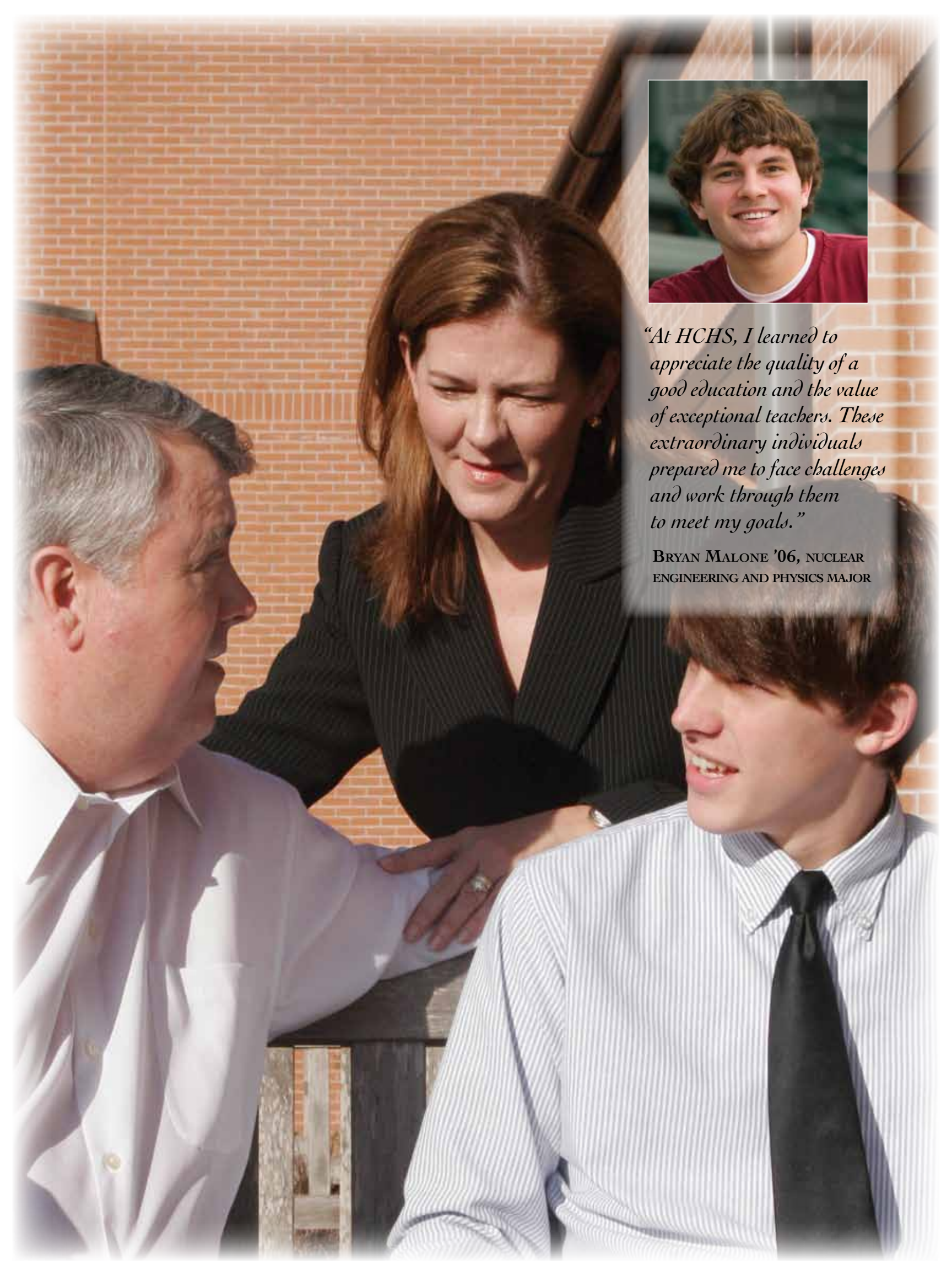
